Zagreb – Plitvice Lakes – Zadar – Kornati Islands – Biograd na Moru – Trogir – Split – Dubrovnik

A unique tour in Croatia includes the main touristic visits of always-vibrant Zagreb, the capital of Croatia, the seaside with beautiful historical towns and one of the most beautiful beaches in the world, amazing Plitvice Lakes national park along with Mediterranean culinary, such as olive oil, dry ham and wine.



Day 01 Zagreb guided tour (Croatia)

Arrival in Zagreb, the capital of Croatia and walking tour through the town, including the fortified Upper Town, the city's historical centre, St. Mark's Church with its multi-coloured roof, the Cathedral, the Croatian National Theatre and the University... City is full of enjoyable architecture, nature and charming history. Dinner and overnight in hotel in Zagreb.

Day 02 Zagreb – Plitvice Lakes – Zadar

Visit one of Croatias' main highlights and part of Unesco's natural heritage list, Plitvice Lakes National Park with magnificent nature, crystal clear water, fairy-tale like 16 lakes, each at a different level joined in a series of cascading waterfalls. Proceed to beautiful Zadar, the main coastal city in North Dalmatia. The town has numerous Roman and other wonderful sights, such as the Roman Forum and St. Donatus Church, magnificent monument of Romanesque architecture. We'll finally reach Zadar's incredible Sea Organ, that exudes wistful sighs when the movement of the sea pushes air through it. Dinner and overnight in the hotel.

Day 03 National park Kornati with fish picknic on the boat – Zadar

Depart to Kornati Islands. Because of extraordinary beautiful landscape, the abundance of natural bays and the rich sea flora and fauna 89 of 152 small islands were declared as a national park in 1980. Fish picnic on the boat. In the late afternoon return to the hotel. Dinner and overnight in hotel.

Day 04 Zadar – Etnoland open air museum – Trogir – Split guided tour

Drive to award-winning Etnoland open air museum, where you'll be welcomed to the traditional Croatian village and listen to Dalmatians tell stories of their ancestors and history, see and learn about old Dalmatian customs and tradition and the 100 year—old Dalmatian way of living in a very interesting, humorous and exceptional way! You will experience traditional Dalmatia cuisine: "Drniški pršut" smoked ham and traditional wine. Proceed to Trogir, also called the "city museum". The old core on the small island is included in the Unesco world heritage list. Drive to one of the most beautiful Dalmatian town Split. Visit Diocletian's Palace, which is the best preserved Roman building in Croatia, Cathedral of St. Dominus, the temple of Jupiter,... Dinner and overnight in hotel.



Day 05 Split – Dubrovnik guided tour

In the morning some free time to explore the city or shopping. Proceed to Dubrovnik that was also declared are Wold heritage by Unesco. The city is surrounded by 1940 meters of gothic and renaissance wall and is considered one of the best-preserved fortifications in Europe. We'll discover the beauty of history through numerous monuments, little streets, churches, ... Dinner and overnight in hotel.

Day 06 Dubrovnik – Departure

If time permits free time in the city. Transfer to the airport.
